



## Downloading Aurora Public Library e-books to a Kindle Fire or Kindle Fire HD

Follow these steps on your device for downloading Aurora Public Library e-books to your Kindle Fire or Kindle Fire HD. You will need your Aurora Public Library card, PIN number, and the OverDrive Media Console app on your device.

### Downloading the OverDrive Media Console App

1. From the home screen on your device, tap Apps and then Store. Type Overdrive Media Console in the search box and tap Go.
2. Tap Download.
3. Tap Open.

### Logging In and Searching for an e-book

4. Tap on the Menu icon and select Get Books.
5. Tap Add a Library.
6. Enter Aurora Public Library or the library's zip codes (60504, 60505, 60506) and tap Search. Select Aurora Public Library, West Branch Library, or Eola Road Branch from the list.
7. Tap the starred Aurora Public Library option. This will open the APL OverDrive e-book catalog.
8. Log in with your Aurora Public Library card and PIN. (Your PIN is usually the last 4 numbers of your home phone number. If this does not work, please call the Library to reset your PIN.)
9. Once logged in, under Settings, you may choose the e-book loan period, up to 21 days maximum.
10. Search for an e-book using the search box or browse book covers or genres/subjects. Click on book covers to get more information about an e-book.

**Tip:** If the small book icon on the cover image is grayed out, that means all copies are checked out. If the book icon is solid darker gray, there is a copy available. If no copies are available, click on Place a Hold.

11. Tap on the book cover for the title you want.
12. Tap Borrow. Tap Download, check the box for EPUB eBook, and tap Confirm & Download. The e-book will download to the Overdrive Media Console app. (You must have an active Wi-Fi connection to download your e-book.)

### Reading your e-book

13. Tap the Menu icon and then Bookshelf Menu icon. Your e-book should display on your Bookshelf in the OverDrive app. Once downloaded, you can enjoy your e-book offline from the app during the check out period. Tap on the book cover to open and read your e-book.
14. To download more books, tap on the Menu icon and then Get Books. You must have an active wireless Internet connection to download e-books.

**Returning and Deleting your e-book**

E-books will automatically expire; there are no late fees and you don't have to worry about returning them. However, if you wish to return the e-book before the lending period expires, press and hold the book jacket on your Bookshelf. From the box that pops up, tap Return and then tap Yes to confirm the return. Do not use Delete until the e-book's lending period is over, as the item will only be deleted, but not returned, and it will still be checked out to your account.

**Note:** OverDrive library e-books will only be able to be read in the OverDrive app. Library e-books will generally not show up in your Kindle's carousel. If you choose the Kindle format at check out, you will be redirected to Amazon.com's website, where you will have to log in to your Kindle account. There, you can send the Kindle library e-book to your device and it will be in the Kindle carousel.

**Downloading OverDrive e-audiobooks**

e-audiobooks from OverDrive can be checked out the same way. Just search for e-audiobooks and choose the MP3 format. This is the only e-audiobook format that will work on the Kindle Fire or Kindle HD. Additionally, e-audiobooks can be downloaded from OneClick Digital.
