

OneClickdigital Quick Start Guide

Download and listen to Recorded Books audiobooks from the Aurora Public Library and OneClickdigital on your computer, smart phone, and most MP3 players and mobile devices. Extensive help and video tutorials are available on the OneClickdigital library site. (<http://aurorail.oneclickdigital.com/Help/Player%20Tutorial.aspx>)

Go to www.aurorapubliclibrary.org and click on Downloadables, followed by OneClickdigital (2nd option from the drop down menu).

Create an account to check out audiobooks.

- Click **Create New Account** at the top right hand side of the screen.
- Enter your library card number and the other requested information.
- Specify your computer operating system, preferred download method and device type. OneClickdigital will remember this information and downloading will be easier.
- Decide if you want to download the media manager to your computer. This makes managing your downloads easier.
- Check out audiobooks by logging in with your username and password.
- Search for specific titles, authors, or narrators by typing in the **Quick Search** box and clicking the magnifying glass.
- Browse by clicking the magnifying glass icon next to the words **Browse—All** and then using the filters on the right hand side of the screen to narrow your search.
- Listen on your computer (either with the OneClickdigital Media Manager or your computer's media player) or transfer your audiobook to a device.
- Download titles directly to Apple and Android devices and Kindle Fires through the OneClickdigital app available on iTunes, Google Play, and the Android App Store on Amazon.
